JESUS SENDS THEM OUT TWO BY TWO (LUKE 10 : 1-20)

(10:1-4) After these things, the Lord appointed other seventy also & **sent them 2 by 2**before His face into every city & place, where He himself would come. Therefore said He to them: The harvest is great, but the laborers are few. Pray to the Lord of the harvest that He will cast forth laborers into His harvest. Go your ways: behold I send you forth as lambs among wolves.

(10:17-20) "& the 70 returned again with joy saying: Lord, even the devils are subject to us. Jesus told them: I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. Behold, I give to you power to read on serpents & scorpions & over all the power of the enemy; & nothing shall by any means hurt you. **(10:20) Nevertheless, in this rejoice not that the spirits are subject to you but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven.**

THE STORY OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN :

(10:25-28) Behold a certain lawyer stood up & tested him saying: Master, what shall I do to inherit eternal life? Jesus said to him: What is written in the law? How do you read it? And he answering said, You must I love the Lord thy God with all thy heart & with all thy soul & with all thy strength & with all thy mind,... and your neighbor as yourself. And Jesus said unto him: You have answered right; **Do this** & you shall live.

(10:29-32) But he willing **to justify **acquit* himself** said to Jesus: "**AND WHO IS MY NEIGHBOR?**" Jesus answering said: A certain man went down from Jerusalem to Jericho, and fell among thieves, who stripped him of his raiment & beat him & departed, leaving **him half-dead**. By chance there came a certain priest that way; who when he saw him, he passed by on the other side. Likewise a Levite, when he was at the place, came & looked on him & passed by on the other side.

(10:33-36) But a certain Samaritan, as he journeyed, came where he was. When he saw him, he had compassion on him. He went to him, bound up his wounds, pouring in oil & wine, and set him on his own beast, brought him to an inn & took care of him. Next day before departing, he took out two pence (denarii) gave them to the host & said unto him, take care of him; Whatever you spend more, when I come again, I will repay you. **(10:36) Which now of these three, do you think was neighbor BECAME NEIGHBOR to him that fell among the thieves.** And he said, He that showed mercy on him. Jesus to him: Go & do likewise.

LUKE 10:38-42 JESUS VISITS MARY AND MARTHA

(10:38) Now it came to pass, as they went, that He entered into a certain village. And certain woman named Martha received him into her house. (whose house?) And Martha had a sister called Mary, who also sat at Jesus' feet & heard His word. But Martha was cumbered about much serving, and came to Him, and said: "Lord don't You care my sister has left me to serve alone? Tell her to therefore come and help me. But Jesus answered and said to her: "Martha, Martha, you art careful and troubled about many things. But one thing is needful, and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her."
